Recently, a gene was discovered that has provided some hope for identification of preventive strategies for the condition. This activity addresses the history, symptoms and risk factors, and potential treatments for this devastating disease.

Emphasis is placed on monitoring for early signs of elevating ICP to protect adequate cerebral perfusion and optimize oxygen delivery.

This activity provides the latest information on advanced diagnostic tools to identify the source of seizures.
